### JUNEAU GUN CLUB WINTER TRAP LEAGUE

Our friends over at the Juneau Gun Club are three weeks into a ten week winter trap league. On Thursday evening from 6-9pm 80 to 100 shotgun shooters show up to try and break 50 clay birds each. Few ever reach that goal but it is great fun even if you miss lots of birds. Each shooter belongs to a team, each team consisting of seven to ten members. It is quite a show with gun smoke lingering in the still, cold winter air enhanced by the trap field lighting. Even if you don't shoot trap you should come by some Thursday and watch for a while. They are also open for public shooting on Sundays 10am-2pm and Wednesday evenings from 6-9pm. They encourage non-shooting families to come out and visit during public hours.
